Although it was several years ago when you were awarded the prestigious Master Club Ambassador Award, we trust that your continued service for the Lord Jesus Christ in your local church is a reflection of what you learned in your Ambassadors for Christ program during your elementary school years. The purpose of the Ambassador Scholarship is to encourage and reward select Ambassador Award recipients who continue to serve the Lord faithfully in their local churches.

You will be competing against other Ambassador Award winners for one of three, \$1,000 Ambassador Scholarships.

This scholarship application is divided into five sections.

SECTION 1: GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Complete a scholarship application only if you are planning to attend college in the fall semester of 2017. You may only apply for the Ambassador Scholarship one time.

If you have not already done so, print or photocopy this document. It is not necessary for you to print and mail the cover page and pages 1, 2, and 3.

Follow the instructions on page 3, and send your e-mail with the attachment of your digital picture (please make sure that you are viewed in the photo holding your Ambassador Award).

Read the Waiver/Consent Form; and follow the directions at the bottom of the page for affixing your signature.

Fill in all information in blue or black ink in SECTIONS three and four. Sign and date your Applicant's Testimony. Place your signed and dated Waiver/Consent Form (page 4) and your Application (pages 5, 6, and 7) in an envelope and mail them to:

Include in your e-mail a recent digital portrait of yourself (holding the Ambassador Award) as a .jpg attachment, and use your name as the file name.

For example, if your name is John Doe: john_doe.jpg.

Insert this statement in your *E-mail subject line*:

“John Doe Digital Photo for Scholarship Application”

Include your first and last name in the body of your e-mail.

Important: The e-mail address that you will use to send your digital photo will establish one of the means by which Master Clubs will announce the winners of the 2017 Ambassador Scholarship.
